Data Protection Information for Events

Legal basis

Special categories of personal data ("sensitive data"), e.g. food intolerances disclosed by you, will solely be processed based on your consent. You can revoke such consent at any time.

Any processing of your personal data beyond above stated (e.g. distribution of a newsletter) will solely be conducted based on your consent. You can revoke such consent at any time.

Storage period

In case the specific storage period is not disclosed at the point in time of the collection of your personal data (e.g. concurrently with the declaration of consent) we will delete the data following the fulfillment of the underlying purpose, unless further legal retention periods provide for a longer storage period. Your personal data shall then be deleted after this storage period.

<u>Exception</u>: In case you agreed to or requested keeping in evidence of your personal data, we can keep this data for the agreed upon time period.
